- Knowledge about environmental, hygiene and cleaning issues, water purification, handling of chemicals, lifecycle considerations, food handling.
- Knowledge about swimming pool finance, payment procedures, budgeting, financial management, promotional techniques and strategies, personal service and cultural differences in their contact with guests.
- Proficiency in undertaking a risk analysis within a swimming facility, the ability to take the initiative to deal with accidents or acute medical emergencies, and the ability to manage incidents.
- Proficiency in executing operational and maintenance tasks, using technical equipment and various cleaning methods.
- Proficiency in using computerised support as a tool to aid administration, communication and financial tasks.
- The ability to perform lifesaving within a swimming facility, CPR (cardio-pulmonary resuscitation), defibrillator, child CPR and to take change in acute medical emergencies, as well as to provide adequate first aid in the case of an accident.
- The ability to run a swimming school for all ages.
- The ability to complete a health profile assessment, undertake nutrition and exercise activities and to perform massage and spa treatments.
- The ability to lead and work with planning, the description of goals and to be involved in quality and development work.
