3. Knowledge, skills and competence profile

The holder of the certificate has:

- Specialist knowledge of animal husbandry and management of machines in agriculture.
- Specialist knowledge of the cultivation of fodder plants, in particular for coarse feed and on the effects of cultivation on the usefulness of feed to different species of animals, as well as adaptation to different growing areas.
- Specialist knowledge of machine chains for coarse feed and manure, as well as different types of intra-farm mechanisation.
- Knowledge of principles of work organisation, work environment, work planning and work processes as well as leadership and communication.
- Knowledge of work management linked to large herds, cultivation, machinery investments and employees on a farm.
- Knowledge of enterprise and entrepreneurship with a focus on business intelligence, business and operational planning, development issues and quality criteria in agriculture.
- Skills in working and participating in the development of less targeted working teams.
- Skills in planning, performing and identifying mechanical, biological and personnel resources for performing specialist tasks in agriculture.
- Skills in assimilating new knowledge and technology, and introducing this into the company.
- Skills in adapting the company to the rules that society places on agriculture and in solving complex problems in the working field.
- Skills in establishing a crop cultivation plan that corresponds to a farm's production direction.
- Competence to independently search for knowledge, analyse and evaluate and use this in practice to develop the company and themselves.
- Competence to be able to balance production goals, quality goals, local and global market, environmental goals and financial goals so as to make independent decisions.
- Competence to be able to monitor operations, take financial and qualitative performance responsibility and complete assigned projects.
- Competence to be able to organise and be responsible for the day-to-day administration of the business.
- Competence to be able to establish a business plan and business strategy for an agricultural business based on a whole consisting of external influences and the market, existing resources, production conditions, personnel, financial analyses and financing.
