3. Knowledge, skills and competence profile

The holder of the certificate has:

- Knowledge of independently explaining the horse's anatomy and physiology, health condition, care, needs and behaviour, as well as explaining feed theory.
- Knowledge of independently and for a riding school explaining the basics of learning, communication and pedagogy.
- Knowledge of describing and explaining in detail basic riding skills in jumping and dressage, as well as the basics of horse training and conditions for training.
- Knowledge of explaining in general terms the operation of a riding school, as well as explaining in detail the management of riding school activities.
- Skills in riding different horses at the required point in training, independently identifying the merits and deficiencies of different horses and proposing appropriate exercises to maintain the horse's point in training.
- Skills in handling varied horses in different common situations in a safe and correct way.
- Skills in planning and evaluating lessons in writing, as well as independently conducting and following up lessons for varied groups at individual and group level.
- Skills in predicting, in consultation with the responsible person, the need for, designing procedures for and carrying out all existing activities in riding school facilities, such as the care of horses, equipment, stables, riding houses and surrounding areas, as well as feed handling.
- Competence to independently, on the basis of SRL 1, conduct lessons in riding, horse studies and riding skills and reflect and communicate shortcomings /merits in their own practice for continued learning and development.
- Competence to adapt their riding to the horse's condition. Analyse their performance and give development proposals.
- Competence to assess, evaluate and develop students' knowledge, skills and attitudes in relation to horses and riding, as well as be a role model.
- Competence, in consultation with the responsible person, to assess and manage the horse from the ground in a safe manner with the aim of achieving safety, good physique, rideability and sustainability.
