3. Knowledge, skills and competence profile

The holder of the certificate has:

- Specialist knowledge of a wide range of annual plants in terms of identification, phases of development and care.
- Knowledge and overview of different activities in the green industries.
- Knowledge of the consequences of changes in soil conditions in terms of the competitive abilities of plants.
- Specialist knowledge of the classification and care of grass surfaces.
- Knowledge of resilient park management.
- Knowledge of European garden culture.
- Skills in identifying, valuing and using resources in the green industries.
- Skills in analysing a habitat and suggesting plant material suitable for the specific habitat.
- Skills in identifying and describing a wide range of annual plants, as well as habitat requirements.
- Skills in describing growth phases and how they should be cared for so as to achieve the desired result.
- Skills in identifying, planning, prioritising and performing work at the beginning of the growth season.
- Skills in identifying different soil types and prioritising and performing plantings that are adapted to the habitat.
- Skills in making compost.
- Competence to independently and in a quality conscious manner cultivate, care for and develop green environments with an ecologically holistic approach.
- Competence to independently develop proposals for changing different green environments.
- Competence to reflect on and problematise plant choices from a sustainability perspective.
- Competence to independently justify the qualities of a planting plan based on habitat, hardiness, aesthetics, economy and sustainability.
- Competence to work with good craftsmanship.
- Competence to independently identify resources, plan the preparatory work, perform sowing and retraining and complete the plant culture in a quality-assured and professionally correct way for the specific planting.
- Competence to quality assure and evaluate the work in the sector for professional development and further learning.
